ARENA PROTOCOLS PER PROVINCE OF MANITOBA PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS

- **Group sizes cannot exceed 10 participants plus coaches/instructors. Note – if you plan on holding full ice scrimmages your group cannot exceed 16 skaters and 4 goalies. See attached Scrimmage update received from the Province.**
- **Maximum two groups of 10 on the ice surface at one time. Instructors must remain with their designated group and the two groups cannot interact at any time on or off the ice.**
- **No more than 12 persons in the dressing room at any time. Only two dressing rooms per booking. NO PARENTS IN DRESSING ROOMS AT ANY TIME.**
- **Participants cannot enter until 30 minutes prior to their booking and must depart the dressing room within 30 minutes of the session ending.**
- **Only one Parent/Guardian/Spectator per participant and they must remain seated in the stands or wait outside the facility until the session is over. No waiting in the common areas at any time.**
- **Hand sanitizer use and masks are mandatory for all spectators/parents and participants and coaches/instructors must wear their masks on the ice surface.**
- Participants should bring their own labeled water bottle. No other food or drink is permitted.
- Physical Distancing must be adhered to when not on ice surface.
- Coaches/Instructors/Participants must use the self-screening tool before coming to facility.

- Coaches/Instructors/Participants must stay home when ill and users are not allowed entry if they are ill with COVID-19 symptoms. Users will be expected to advise their participants that daily self-screening is required before attending the facility and they are prohibited from attending the camp/session if they have COVID-19 symptoms.

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Scrimmages

Updated guidance from Public Health under the current public health order allows for scrimmages to take place amongst the same team. With this guidance we will begin allowing scrimmages effective April 21, 2021.

MAXIMUM PARTICIPANTS ON ICE IS 20 (2 GROUPS OF 10 MAXIMUM). GROUPS MUST BE SPLIT AND ASSIGNED THEIR OWN DRESSING ROOM.

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.

Scrimmages must be kept to the same team at all times, they are not a replacement for games and as such teams should not be mixed. Scrimmages should not include any referees to ensure it remains a scrimmage and not a game.

At no time can the number of players, including goalies on the ice exceed ten for full ice or ten per half if the ice is divided. This will result in a maximum of 4v4 play for full ice.

4v4 Play the maximum number of skaters is 16, with up to four goalies. If only two goalies are present, they can be involved with both groups of eight for scrimmages. The two additional goalie spots cannot be filled by players to ensure that there are two groups of eight players that do not interact with one another. The two groups of eight should be reasonably kept from interacting with one another. Each group should have their own bench and it should not be shared with the other group. Players are asked to distance as best as possible on the benches.

To reduce interaction amongst groups changing on the fly is not allowed.

Each user is responsible to ensure that ALL other Public Health Orders and Facility Protocols are followed at all times while utilizing our facility. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the current ice slot and all future ice at the user's cost.
